Quest began with 10 students in 1993 and currently serves over 300 students annually from Collier County. Quest provides free tuition to more than 1/3 of their students. Each year, they have to turn some away. While some pay a fee for their services, they are always striving to be in a position so the services are accessible to all who need them.

The Ricky King Children’s Fund enriches the lives of children with disabilities in Southwest Florida by providing essential medical equipment and services in times of need. Many of the children helped by the Ricky King Children’s Fund fall between the cracks of larger organizations and insurance agencies. They are often the last hope for so many families. These severely handicapped children have several ailments and do not have an organization that meets their immediate needs. These children suffer from such conditions and diseases as cerebral palsy, paralysis, congenital muscular dystrophy, autism, spina bifida and hydrocephalus to name a few. These children often come from hard working families that are struggling with the financial obligations of having a child with a disability. There is no other non-profit providing medical equipment to disabled children in Collier, Lee and Charlotte Counties. The Ricky King Children’s Fund has been in existence since 1978.
